#### SafeSport Statement for Membership Renewal

The following code of conduct applies to all participants in activities hosted, supported, sponsored or engaged in by U.S. Figure Skating and HFSC including but not limited to competitions, exhibitions, training camps and local rink activities.

I recognize that my participation or my child's in all the activities associated with U.S. Figure Skating and HFSC is an honor and privilege that carries certain responsibilities. I agree to fully abide by the rules and guidelines set forth by U.S. Figure Skating or its properly designated agents.

#### U.S. Figure Skating Member Code of Conduct GR 1.02

I recognize that my participation in all activities hosted, supported, sponsored or engaged in by U.S. Figure Skating, including but not limited to competitions, exhibitions and training camps, is an honor and privilege that carries certain responsibilities. I agree to fully abide by the rules and guidelines set forth by U.S. Figure Skating or its properly designated agents. As a precondition to participation in activities hosted, supported, sponsored or engaged in by U.S. Figure Skating, I will adhere to the following tenets in good faith:

- A. I will exhibit the highest standards of fairness, ethical behavior and genuine good sportsmanship in all of my relations with others.
- B. I will not damage public or private property. I understand that I may be held financially responsible for damage deemed to be wantonly or willfully executed on my part, and that I may be subject to disciplinary action by U.S. Figure Skating.

- H. I understand that all disciplinary proceedings will be conducted pursuant to Article XXV, Section 3, of the U.S. Figure Skating bylaws, and that my rights and remedies are derived therefrom.

# ASSUMPTION OF RISK, WAIVER AND RELEASE, AND INDEMNIFICATION AGREEMENT

In consideration of the opportunity to participate in U.S. Figure Skating sanctioned events and activities during the 2023-24 U.S. Figure Skating Competition Season ("Events and Activities"), the undersigned, individually, and on behalf of his/her heirs, personal representatives, administrators, agents, successors and assigns (collectively referred to herein as "Participant"), AGREES TO ASSUME THE RISK AND RESPONSIBILITY, TO RELEASE AND TO INDEMNIFY U.S. Figure Skating, its directors, officers, members, employees, officials, committees, volunteers, clubs, affiliates, sponsors, representatives, agents, successors and assigns, including the host club, local organizing committee and any other entity responsible for the hosting and/or conduct of the Events and Activities (collectively referred to herein as "U.S. Figure Skating"), as follows:

- 1. Assumption of Risk and Responsibility. Participant fully understands and appreciates the risks of injury that may occur in ice skating or in the course of preparing for, participating in and traveling to or from the Events and Activities. The risks of injury that may occur include, but are not limited to, the risk of, serious bodily injury, viral infections, bacterial infections and risk of other communicable diseases and illness, permanent disability, paralysis and death (collectively referred to herein as "Risks"). Participant acknowledges that Participant voluntarily engages in such Events and Activities with adequate knowledge of such Risks; and agrees that Participant fully assumes all such Risks and all legal and financial responsibility for (a) any and all injuries or damages, whether to person or property, that Participant may in any manner sustain in connection therewith or in the conduct and management of the Events and Activities, including such injury or damage that may result from the negligence of U.S. Figure Skating or from some other cause and (b) all treatment, hospitalization and other care rendered to Participant in the event of Participant's illness, injury or other emergency circumstance in connection with participation in the Events and Activities, subject to any applicable insurance coverage.
- 2. Release and Indemnification. Participant hereby fully and forever releases, discharges, holds harmless, and agrees to indemnify U.S. Figure Skating from and against any and all liabilities, claims, demands, lawsuits, damages, and judgments, present or future, known or unknown, valid or invalid, direct or consequential, together with reasonable costs and attorneys' fees, which result directly or indirectly from damages, losses, injuries or death to Participant, Participant's property, other persons or property incurred during or in connection with any activities associated with or being a part of the Events and Activities and the conduct and management thereof, including any participation, travel or medical treatment, hospitalization or other care rendered in connection with the Events and Activities, whether such loss, damage, injury or death results from the negligence of U.S. Figure Skating or from some other cause.

## HELENA FIGURE SKATING CLUB 2023-2024 VOLUNTEER POLICY

Helena Figure Skating Club (HFSC) is a 501 C (3) Non- Profit Organization with a Board of Trustees and a membership of skaters, families and volunteers. The organization relies heavily on fundraising efforts to continue operation, specifically ice rental. The HFSC club rents ice from the Helena Ice Arena for skaters to take lessons, practice programs and to train at all levels in the sport of figure skating. The necessity of club ice rentals allows skaters to train competitively and safely train programs and take lessons with certified instructors. The rental of ice guarantees skaters the time needed to progress in the sport.

Each season the HFSC runs fundraising events like ice shows, competitions and various fundraisers. The HFSC also commits to volunteer hours with the Helena Bighorn Hockey Club in exchange for the profits from a special jersey auction. The special jersey auction profited \$7000 last season. The events and hockey agreement subsidize rising ice rental costs. With ice costs continuing to rise, the needs of our club expanding and the volunteer hours growing the HFSC has adopted a volunteer policy to accompany the membership of each of our member families.

By registering for the 2023-2024 membership season you are committing to volunteering:

- 1) Three hours of your time to a HFSC event (aka events)
  - a) Events included but are not limited to; winter ice show, spring ice show & competition/testing.
  - b) Dates of events will be announced at least one month in advance.
- 2) For three Helena Bighorn hockey games for the 2023-2024 season (aka games)
  - a) The duration of time varies and is dictated by Helena Bighorn owners and management.
  - b) Dates and times will be announced by the Helena Bighorn Hockey Club and shared with membership as soon at the schedule is made public.
  - c) Examples from the previous season include: taking tickets/ stamping hands, taking tickets for cash and card payments, verifying tickets for VIP room guests and durations ranged from 1.5 hours to 3 hours. All volunteer positions come with and basic on the job training and support and can be executed once training is complete.
- 3) Fulfillment of Volunteer Hours Requires:
  - i) signing up for volunteer time for events and games
  - ii) arriving on time for registered times for events and games
  - iii) staying for the duration of volunteer commitment for events and games (or until dismissed)
  - iv) meeting minimum age requirement of volunteers- age 12
  - v) additional requests that fall within the scope of the agreement with the Helena Bighorns Hockey Club and/or HFSC that qualify as necessary to complete a volunteer task

The 2023-2024 Volunteer Policy applies to each family joining HFSC. The 2023-2024 Volunteer policy does not apply to each specific member at this time. The volunteer policy is designed to help support the volunteer hours that are needed, but it will not cover the nearly 300 volunteer hours that need to be filled each season. This policy is a minimum commitment and will in no way cover all the volunteer hours needed to gain funds to keep our skaters on the ice. The policy will only lighten the load on each member so we can continue to purchase ice and provide an essential to our members.
